REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING:

The Rainsville City Council met in regular session on June 2, 2014, at 5:30 pm at Agri-Center with the following members present: Mayor Nick Jones. Councilmembers: Joey Graham, David Holt, Melissa Ledbetter, Brandon Freeman and Rodger Lingerfelt. City Attorney: Dara Patterson.

Mayor Jones called the meeting to order and called the roll.

A motion was made by Graham and seconded by Freeman to approve the May 19, 2014, regular council meeting minutes as presented and read by the clerk. Motion carried unanimously.

Item #1. Mayor Jones made a recommendation to pass and adopt **RESOLUTION PROVIDING FOR THE CITY OF RAINSVILLE PARTICIPATION IN THE “SALES TAX HOLIDAY” AS AUTHORIZED BY ACT NO. 2006-574 IN AUGUST OF 2014.** After a discussion, a motion was made by Graham and seconded by Ledbetter to accept this recommendation to pass and adopt this Resolution as presented. Motion carried unanimously.

Item #2. Mayor Jones made a recommendation to pass and adopt **RESOLUTION – ACT 3024-439** providing all funds necessary to the Employee’s Retirement System to cover the cost of the one-time lump sum payment as provided for this Act for those eligible retirees. After a discussion, a motion was made by Holt and seconded by Lingerfelt to accept this recommendation to pass and adopt this Resolution as presented. Motion carried unanimously.

Item #3. A motion was made by Graham and seconded by Freeman to pay McDaniel’s Garage for repairs to the sanitation truck in the amount of \$2,215.73 and an estimated cost of \$1,000.00 to \$1,500.00 to repair the front loader garbage truck. Motion carried with all in favor.

Item #4. A motion was made by Graham and seconded by Ledbetter to pay Johnny Clem \$775.00 for repairs to the septic tank at the Lion’s Club Rodeo Field. Motion carried with all in favor.

Item #5. A motion was made by Graham and seconded by Ledbetter to sponsor a hole in the Chamber of Commerce Scholarship Golf Tournament in the amount of \$1,000.00. Motion carried with all in favor.

Item #6. A motion was made by Holt and seconded by Freeman to approve the following expenses presented by Chief Centers for the police department, a police vest and vest cover, two printers, two lap top computers and three jail mattresses. Motion carried with all in favor.

Item #7. A motion was made by Ledbetter and seconded by Holt to add a Recreational Trail to the Land and Water Conservation Fund Grant for the Development of a Community Splash Pad. Motion carried with all in favor.

Item #8. A motion was made by Freeman and seconded by Holt to hire Cade Willingham to work at the swimming pool. Motion carried with all in favor.

Item #9. A motion was made by Freeman and seconded by Graham to order a load of brick dust for the Field of Dreams at a cost of less than \$2,000.00. Motion carried with all in favor.

Item #10. A motion was made by Lingerfelt and seconded by Holt to purchase an ad in the amount of \$150.00 from the Plainview Cheerleaders. Motion carried with all in favor.

Item #11. A motion was made by Lingerfelt and seconded by Freeman to purchase an ad in the amount of \$300.00 from the Plainview Band Boosters. Motion carried with all in favor.

A motion was made by Ledbetter and seconded by Holt to the pay the monthly bills as presented the city treasurer. Motion carried with all in favor.

A motion was made by Graham and seconded by Ledbetter to adjourn at 6:00 pm. Motion carried unanimously.
