PUBLIC HEARING

With proper notice being given the Rainsville City Council held a public hearing on the 7th day of July, 2014, at 5:00 pm at the Agri Center with the following members present: Mayor Pro Tem Rodger Lingerfelt. Councilmembers: Joey Graham, David Holt, Melissa Ledbetter and Brandon Freeman.

City Attorney: Dara Patterson. Absent: Mayor Nick Jones.

Mayor Pro-Tem Lingerfelt called the public hearing to order.

The purpose of this public hearing was to move the voting place from the Northeast Alabama Agri-Business Center to the DeKalb County Schools Coliseum at the request of the poll workers and the DeKalb County Commission.

Mayor Pro-Tem Lingerfelt asked if anyone was present to speak on behalf of the moving of this polling place back to the DeKalb Schools Coliseum from the Agri-Center (where it was moved after the April 27, 2011 Tornado). No one was present.

A motion was made by Graham and seconded by Ledbetter to pass and adopt **Resolution No. 07-07-14** to authorize relocating the voting location from the Northeast Alabama Agri-Business Center to the DeKalb County Schools Coliseum. Motion carried unanimously.

With no more discussion, a motion was made by Graham and seconded by Freeman to adjourn this public hearing. Motion carried unanimously.
