Rainsville is also home to [DeKalb County's Vocational Technical School](#), offering classes ranging from auto body and welding to business and cosmetology to students throughout the county school system.

[Northeast Alabama Community College](#) (www.nacc.edu) is a two-year public college located five miles west of Rainsville. The college has excellent programs in nursing, performing arts, and other fields. A new state-of-the-art theater, constructed in the late 1990s, is one of northeast Alabama's most prized possessions.
