OUTDOOR RECREATION

Rainsville is in the heart of Alabama's beautiful and rugged Mountain/Lakes region. If you like hiking, biking, outdoor photography, hunting, fishing or boating, the area is hard to beat. Alabama's largest freshwater lake is only 15 miles away. Two state parks, and a breathtaking national preserve are in the area.

GOLF. Northeast Alabama's climate allows for golfing year round. There are seven public, and four private courses within 35 miles of Rainsville.

POPULATION According to Census Bureau data, Rainsville's population grew about 32 percent between 1980 and 1990 (from 2,921 to 3,875), and about 16 percent between 1990 and 2000 (from 3,875 to 4,499).

WEATHER Rainsville's average annual rainfall is 42.15 inches. The average July temperature is 75.8 degrees. The average January temperature is 35.8 degrees. The average annual temperature is 57 degrees.
