

ORDINANCE NUMBER 10- 03 -94

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE ADOPTED 8-15-83 AND TITLED ZONING
ORDINANCE RAINSVILLE, ALABAMA

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RAINSVILLE,
ALABAMA, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I. The Ordinance adopted 8-15-83 entitled Zoning Ordinance
Rainsville, Alabama, is hereby amended as follows:


The official zoning map of the City of Rainsville constituting a
portion of the zoning ordinance is amended to change the use district of
the following described real estate from R-1 Residential District to B-3
General Business District:

From the NE corner of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 18, Township 6
S of Range 8 E, run S of the E-line of said forty 124 ft.; thence W
and parallel with the N line of said forty 360 ft., more or less,
to the Easterly ROW of Alabama Highway No. 75; thence NE with said
Highway 147 ft., more or less, to the N line of said forty; thence
E on said N line 285 ft., more or less, to the point of beginning,
being 1 acre, more or less, herein conveyed, said lands being in
DeKalb County, Alabama.

SECTION II. The Clerk shall cause the official zoning map to be
changed to reflect this amendment with a notation on the same containing
the date of this ordinance and this ordinance number.


SECTION III. This Ordinance shall become effective following its


