ORDINANCE NUMBER 12-21-06 LICENSE ORDINANCE

An ordinance to provide a license schedule for the year of 2001, beginning January 1, 2001, and ending December 31, 2001, and for each year thereafter, successively and continuously, respectively for the divers businesses, trades, and professions engaged in and carried on in the City of Rainsville, Alabama; to provide a fee for issuance of said Ordinance and to provide penalties for its violation; to repeal any other ordinance or parts in conflict herewith.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RAINSVILLE, ALABAMA, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: License Schedule:

The following be and is hereby enacted and declared to be the schedule of licenses for the term beginning January 1, 2001, and ending December 31, 2001, and for each and every year thereafter, successively and continuously, respectively for the divers businesses, occupations. trades and professions engaged and carried on in the City of Rainsville, Alabama, and each and every person, firm or corporation (hereafter collectively or individually referred to as person) herein enumerated shall take out and pay for a license or licenses in such manner and sum herein provided for the year respectively in which they engage in such business, occupation. trade or profession as follows, to-wit:

- (a) Fire or Marine, \$4.00 on each \$100.00 and major fraction thereof, of gross premiums, less return premiums on policies issued during the preceding year on property located in the City of Rainsville; provided that new companies shall pay a flat minimum of \$20.00 license before being allowed to do business which there shall be an adjustment at the expiration of the year on the basis set out above.
- (b) All other insurance companies than those included in sub-section of (a) of this section each \$10.00, plus \$1.00 on each \$100.00 and major fraction thereof of the gross premiums, less return premiums received during the preceding year on policies issued during said year, in said City; provided that new companies shall pay a flat minimum license of \$20.00 covering both items above on which there shall be an adjustment on the basis at the expiration of the year.

(c) On December 31 of each year or within 60 days thereafter each insurance company which did any business in the City of Rainsville during any part of the preceding year shall, furnish the Mayor or City Clerk a statement in writing duly certified showing the full and true amount of gross premiums received during the preceding year as provided under this article and shall accompany such statement with the amount of license tax due according to section 11-51-120 and 11-51-121, 1975 Code of Alabama - as amended.

Failure to furnish such statement or to pay such sum shall subject the company and its agents to such penalties as the ordinance of the City of Rainsville has prescribed for doing business therein without a license.

SECTION 2: Due Date

All licenses under this schedule are due and payable January 1, 2001, and the first calendar day of each year subsequent thereto, and delinquent February 1, 2001, and the first day of February in each year subsequent thereto.

SECTION 3: Delinquent Penalty

That at any time after February 1, 2001, and the first day of February in each year subsequent thereto, there shall be due and collected on all delinquent licenses an additional fee equal to ten percent (10%) of the original amount of license and after March 1, 2001, and the first day of March in each year subsequent thereto, there shall be due and collected on all delinquent licenses an additional fee equal to twenty percent (20%) of the original amount of license. Penalties may be paid prior to arrest in lieu of penalty for violating this ordinance. In cases where licenses remain unpaid as of May 1, 2001, or the first day of May in each year subsequent thereto, the place of business shall be closed.

SECTION 4: Fee for Issuing

That at the time of taking out and paying for said license, there shall be paid a fee of \$5.00 for the issuance of each license to the License Clerk, or other such authority, for the use of the City.

SECTION 5: Each Line of Business Demands Separate License

That any person, firm, company or corporation dealing in two or more of the articles, or engaged in two or more of the businesses, trades, vocations, occupations, or professions, enumerated in Section 1 of this ordinance covering separate licenses, shall pay for and take out a license for each item enumerated.

SECTION 6: License Based on Value of Volume

That in all cases where the amount to be paid for license depends upon the capital invested, or the value of the goods, or stocks, or amount of sales receipts, or income, it shall be the duty of the applicant for such license to render to the License Clerk a sworn statement of such facts upon which the amount of the license depends, and the License Clerk shall not be required to receipt for any money paid for such license, nor to issue such license until said proof is furnished.

SECTION 7: Term for Which License is Issued

License Ordinance 2001 Page Eleven

That the foregoing schedule of licenses shall be for the calender year, and that a full amount thereof shall be charged and collected, provided that where the license is issued after July 1st, one half (½) of the annual rate shall be charged and collected (this is not to apply to those subjects for which daily, weekly, or monthly licenses are provided). No license issued under this schedule shall extend beyond December 31, 2001, or beyond the 31st day of December of each year subsequent thereto for which the license is issued.

SECTION 8: Unlawful to Do Business Before Obtaining License

That it shall be unlawful for any person, firm, company or corporation to engage in any of the aforesaid businesses, trades, vocations, occupations, or professions in this City during the year 2001, or during any license year subsequent thereto, from and after the passage of this ordinance as required by law, without first having procured license therefor.

SECTION 9: Hourly Workers

That persons who are hired on a part-time, seasonal, occasional, or casual basis to perform work or a service which would require a license if the worker were engaged in said business, occupation or profession at a full-time basis, shall be required to purchase a business license of the appropriate profession, business, or occupation that would customarily perform the work and/or services being performed. Hourly workers who are on the payroll of a firm, corporation or business and are entitled to the same compensation and fringe benefits as other hourly workers on the payroll of the employer are not required to hold a business license; however, nothing within this ordinance shall be construed to authorize hourly workers to perform services which would otherwise require a particular occupational license issued by the State of Alabama, or an instrumentality thereof.

SECTION 10: Transfer of License

That no license issued under the foregoing schedule of licenses shall be transferred, except by the consent of the Revenue Department of the City of Rainsville; and such consent shall not take effect nor be valid until such transfer be endorsed across the face of the license receipt by the License Clerk, and no license shall be transferred, at any event, more than once, and never from one entity to another.

SECTION 11: Salaried Professional Employees

When any person claims any concession on kind of professional license provided for in this code because of such person being either the employer or the employee, such person shall not be exempt from payment of the license provided in the Ordinance until both the employer and employee have furnished to the License Clerk sworn affidavits or other evidence satisfactory to the License Clerk setting out all the facts and conditions on regard to the employment, with such facts and conditions being as would ordinarily substantiate the employment claim.

SECTION 12: False Oath to Procure License

It shall be unlawful for any person to give, submit, exhibit, or present to the City of Rainsville, the License Clerk, the City Clerk, or to any license inspector or collector of the City, any false, deceptive or misleading statement, affidavit, certificate, book or record entry, or other document relating to the amount of capital invested, the value of goods, stocks or merchandise, the amounts or volume of sales, receipts or commissions, the number of employees, those who are not employees, those who are not employees, the number of vehicles used, or any other date or record of information required by the License ordinance of the City of Rainsville to determine the amount of the license due.

SECTION 13: Place of Business Designated

License Ordinance 2001 Page Twelve

Each person desiring to engage in any trade, business, or occupation for which a license is required and for which a fixed place of business is required, shall designate the place at which trade, business or occupation is to be carried on, and the license to be issued thereunder shall designate such place; and, such license shall authorize the carrying on of such trade, business or occupation only at such place. For each place at which said trade, business or occupation is carried on, a separate license shall be paid and secured.

SECTION 14: Council's Power to Amend Schedule

That adoption of this schedule of licenses shall not waive or abridge the right of the City Council to alter, increase, decrease, revoke, waive or amend in any manner any of the above licenses at any time; and, when any increase is made, unless the same be paid within 15 days, the former license shall be revoked and no further business shall be carried on thereunder, nor shall it abridge the right of the City Council as to licensing other subjects that are not included in the schedule. And when any such change, increase or addition is made, the same shall be paid for the calendar year, if required, before July 1st and for a full half-year after July 1st, unless there is a daily, weekly, or monthly rate appertaining.

SECTION 15: Exemption of Interstate Commerce

That no provision of this ordinance shall be so construed as to tax interstate commerce, foreign, or federal business.

SECTION 16: Licensing in Police Jurisdiction

That any person, firm, company or corporation engaged in the business, occupation, trade or profession that is carried on without the corporate limits of the City of Rainsville, but within the police jurisdiction of the City of Rainsville, such person, firm, company, or corporation shall pay into the treasury of the City of Rainsville, a license fee for doing said business, occupation, trade, or profession, in the sum of one-half of the schedule listed in SECTION 1 hereof respectively.

SECTION 17: Penalty

That any person, firm, company, corporation, or agent thereof, violating any provision of this ordinance shall, upon conviction, be punished by a fine not to exceed \$500.00 for each offense, or by imprisonment not exceeding six (6) months, either or both, at the discretion of the court trying same, and that each day of violation shall constitute a separate offense.

SECTION 18: License Clerk

The Mayor shall appoint a License Clerk who shall work together with the Revenue Enforcement Officer/License Inspector, and who shall be in charge of the responsibility of the issuing of all licenses provided for by this Ordinance, shall maintain an accurate and appropriate record for the issuance of said licenses, and perform such other duties regarding the enforcement of said license ordinance as he/she may be directed from time to time by the Mayor.

SECTION 19: License Inspector

The mayor may designate a License Inspector who shall enforce the provisions of said Ordinance, and who shall have the authority to issue citations for the violations of this Ordinance, and the License Inspector may arrest persons charged with the violation of this Ordinance, provided however, that the License Inspector shall, prior to said arrest, comply with the Peace Officers Standards and Training Commission requirements. If said License Inspector is certified by the Peace Officers Standards Training Commission, he shall be authorized to wear a side arm

while performing his duties as License Inspector. Said License Inspector shall be paid an annual salary to be established by City Council. The Mayor may, in his discretion, designate one of the

City police officers to serve as License Inspector who shall perform the duties as outlined above; however, nothing within this ordinance shall take away or otherwise diminish any rights of the police officer as established by the personnel policies of the City of Rainsville.

SECTION 20:

If any part, section, or subdivision of this Ordinance shall be held unconstitutional or invalid for any reason, such holding shall not be construed to invalidate or impair the remainder of this Ordinance, which shall continue in full force and effect, notwithstanding such holding.
