ORDINANCE NO. 12-6-99

AN ORDINANCE FIXING AND ESTABLISHING SPEED LIMITS AND PARKING REGULATIONS IN THE CITY OF RAINSVILLE, ALABAMA, AND ITS POLICE JURISDICTION:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RAINSVILLE, ALABAMA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. No person shall operate a motor vehicle at a greater speed than 65 miles per hour in the following listed zones of the City:

On Alabama Highway 35 from the South city limit, Milepost 28.4, northerly to Milepost 29.94, a distance of 1.54 miles.

Section 2. No person shall operate a motor vehicle at a greater speed than 55 miles per hour in the following listed zones of the City:

On Alabama Highway 35 from Milepost 29.94; northerly to Thompson Avenue, Milepost 30.94, a distance of 1.00 miles.

On Alabama Highway No. 35 from Milepost 32.55 northerly to Milepost 33.25, a distance of 0.7 miles.

On Alabama Highway No. 75 from Dilbeck Street (Milepost 85.84) northerly to the N City limits (Milepost 88.61), a distance of 2.77 miles.

Section 3. No person shall operate a motor vehicle at a greater speed than 50 miles per hour in the following listed zones of the city:

On Highway No. 75 from its intersection with George Wallace Street southward to the southmost city limit, a distance of about 1.30 miles.

The entire length of Marshall Road and Dewey Williams Street.

Section 4. No person shall operate a motor vehicle at a greater speed than 45 miles per hour in the following listed zones of the city:

On Alabama Highway 35 from Thompson Avenue, Milepost 30.94, northerly to 0.30 miles South of Alabama Highway 75, Milepost 31.45, a distance of 0.51 miles.

On Alabama Highway 35 from 0.3 miles N of Alabama 75 (Milepost 32.05), northerly to Milepost 32.55, a distance of 0.5 miles.

On Alabama Highway 75 from Rose Street (Milepost 85.38), northerly to Dilbeck Street (Milepost 85.84), a distance of 0.46 miles.

Section 5. No person shall operate a motor vehicle at a greater speed than 40 miles per hour in the following listed zones of the city:

On Highway 75 from its intersection with George Wallace Street (Milepost 84.58) northward to its intersection with Rose Street (Milepost 85.38), a distance of about 0.80 miles.

On Bluffview Drive, Browns Chapel Road, Carlyle Road, Carter Street, Chambers Ave., Chavies Road, Clements Road, Collier Circle, Dilbeck Road, Everett Road, Fortner Road, Garrett Street, George Wallace Drive, Heaton Road, Horton Road, Industrial Drive, Kain Ave., Kirk Road, Lingerfelt Road, Love Road, Maple Ave., Morgan Road, Parker Ave from George Wallace Drive to city limits, Rainbow Ave. NW, Rainbow Ave. SW, Shankles Road, Short Ave., Skaggs Road, Thompson Ave., and V.F.W. Road

On any city streets listed hereinabove which contain residential zones or business districts, then the speed limit shall be 25 miles per hour on said street until leaving the residential and/or business zone.

Section 6. No person shall operate a motor vehicle at a greater speed than 35 miles per hour in the following listed zones of the city:

On Alabama Highway 35 from 0.30 miles South of Alabama Highway 75, (Milepost 31.45),

northerly to a point 0.30 miles North of Alabama Highway 75. Milepost 32.05, a distance of 0.6 miles.

Adams Ave., Adelia Street, Bailey Ave., Bartlett Ave., Bell Street, Boozer Road, Briarwood Lane, Broadway Street, Burgess Ave., Cedar Street, Church Ave., Circle Drive, Country Club Lane, Croft Ave., Dalton Street, Davis Ave., Deerman Ave., DeKalb Drive, Dupree Circle, First Ave., Fourth Ave., Grimes Street, Hancock Drive, Harrison Street, Hickory Lane, Hicks Drive, Hicks Street, Hodges Street, Jackson Street, Johnson Street, Kilgore Street, Laney Street, Langley Loop, Laverne Drive, Lee Ave., Lynn Street, Malcom Ave., Martin Lane, Massingil Drive, Michelle Drive, Miller Street, Mims Ave., Mitchell Ave., Mitchell Drive, Mo Street, Mockingbird Lane, Nappier Street, North Ave., Oak Ave., Park Lane, Parker Ave. from Broadway Street to George Wallace Drive, Pine Hill Road, Poplar Drive, Rabbit Run Road, Rains Ave., Ranch Road, Ray Ave., Richards Street, Robertson Ave., Rodeo Lane, Rogers Street, Rose Street, Rosewood Lane, Sam Ellis Drive, Samples Street, Sand Mtn. Drive, Santileon Lane, Scott Ave., N, Scott Ave. S, Second Ave., Shankles Circle, Soloman Ave., Star Road, Suttles Aye., Third Ave., Tiger Lane, Tucker Road, Tumlin Street, Turner Ave., Vaughn Drive, Vista View Drive, Wade Street, White Circle, White Street, Wigley Lane, Wilkins Street, Willingham Street, Wilson Ave., Wisner Street, and Woodridge Circle.

On any city streets listed hereinabove which contain residential zones or business districts, then the speed limit shall be 25 miles per hour on said street until leaving the residential and/or business zone.

Section 7. No person shall operate a motor vehicle at a greater speed than 25 miles per hour in the following listed zones of the city:

On Goggans Drive, Gray Street, Lofton Ave., Mince Circle, Mince Drive, Nixon Street and Plainview Street.

Section 8. No person shall operate a motor vehicle at a greater speed than 15 miles per hour in the following listed zone of the city:

Northside Drive

Section 9. No person shall operate a motor vehicle at a greater speed than 25 miles per hour on any street or alley located within the corporate limits of the City of Rainsville not specifically mentioned or set out herein.

No person shall operate a motor vehicle at a greater speed than 25 miles per hour in any residential area.

Section 10. Notwithstanding anything herein to the contrary, the speed limit along Alabama Highway No. 35 in the Plainview School area shall be 35 miles per hour between 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 a.m. and 2:30 p.m to 3:30 p.m. on days when school is in season. A sign designating the school zone limits shall be posted where these limits begin and the school zone limits shall continue until the next posted speed limit sign.

Section 11. No person shall park a motor vehicle in any designated area when said prohibited area is properly marked with yellow paint and/or signed.

Section 12. Any person violating any provision of this ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, be punished by a fine of not more than \$500.00 or may be imprisoned in the municipal jail for a period not exceeding six months, or by both such fine and imprisonment.

Section 13. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 14. Each section of this ordinance shall be considered to be several and separate and any determination that a particular section is void shall not void the entire ordinance but shall void only that particular section.

Section 15. This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage, approval, and bublication as provided by law.
