ORDINANCE NUMBER _ 2-1-99-A

AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING STOP SIGNS AT THE INTERSECTION OF PARKER AVENUE AND BROWNS CHAPEL ROAD

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RAINSVILLE, ALABAMA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Council has determined that it will be in the best interest of safety of those using its roads that stop signs be installed at the intersection of Parker Ave. and Browns Chapel Road located in the City of Rainsville. These stop signs shall require all approaching traffic to stop at this intersection; that is, this shall be a four-way stop intersection.

Section 2. Warning signs of the approaching stop signs shall be placed at a distance determined by the Chief of Police to give what he determines is appropriate warning.

Section 3. This ordinance shall become effective immediately following its publication.
