ORDINANCE NUMBER 7-19-10 AMENDMENT TO ZONING ORDINANCE

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE ZONING ORDINANCE NUMBER 8-15-83 ENTITLED ZONING ORDINANCE OF RAINSVILLE, ALABAMA ADDING MINI-WAREHOUSE SELF-STORAGE FACILITIES AS A PERMITTED USE IN B-3 DISTRICT

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF RAINSVILLE, ALABAMA, as follows:

SECTION 1. <u>Article IV Use Districts</u> of the Rainsville Zoning Ordinance Number 8-15-83, <u>Section 4-6. B-3 General Business District</u>, <u>Subsection 4-6-1 Permitted Uses</u>, shall be, and is hereby, amended to read as follows:

- "• Any use allowed as a Permitted Use in the B-2 District
- · Automatic car wash
- · New and used automobile sales and leasing
- Mobile home sales lot
- Recreational vehicle sales lot
- Open air businesses, including retail sales of plant materials, lawn furniture, playground equipment and garden supplies
- · Bowling alleys and similar forms of indoor commercial recreation
- Veterinary hospitals or clinics
- Drive-in restaurants
- Business college or business school
- Mini-warehouse self-storage facilities for the storage of tenant consumers'
 personal property in storage buildings subdivided by permanent partitions into
 individual compartments that are each served by an exterior independent
 entrance under the exclusive control of the tenant consumer and that are used
 only for the storage of personal property; provided, there shall be no outside
 storage of goods or materials of any type on the site of a mini-warehouse self
 storage facility."
