

ORDINANCE NO. 01-21-13

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF RAINSVILLE, ALABAMA, TO EXEMPT CERTAIN "COVERED ITEMS" FROM THE MUNICIPAL SALES AND USE TAX DURING CERTAIN PERIODS, AS AUTHORIZED BY ACT 2012-256, GENERALLY REFERRED TO AS THE STATE SEVERE WEATHER PREPAREDNESS SALES TAX HOLIDAY LEGISLATION.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF RAINSVILLE, ALABAMA, AS FOLLOWS:


Section 1. In conformity with the provisions Act 2012-256 enacted by the Alabama Legislature during the 2012 Regular Session, providing for a State Sales Tax Holiday, the City of Rainsville, Alabama, exempts "covered items" from municipal sales and use tax during the same period, beginning at 12:01 a.m. on Friday, February 22, 2013 and ending at twelve midnight the following Sunday February 24, 2013. This sales tax holiday is referred to as the **Severe Weather Preparedness Sales Tax Holiday**.

Section 2. This ordinance shall be subject to all terms, conditions, definitions, time periods, and rules as provided by Act 2012-256 and Sales Tax Holiday Rule 810-6-3-66.02ER.

Section 3. The City Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to certify a copy of this ordinance under the seal of the City of Rainsville, Alabama, and to forward said certified copy to the Alabama Department of Revenue to be recorded and posted on the Department website.


Section 4. This ordinance shall become effective on January 21, 2013.
