ORDINANCE NUMBER 10-17-2016(B) AMENDMENT TO ZONING ORDINANCE

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE ZONING ORDINANCE NUMBER 08-15-1983, AS AMENDED, ENTITLED ZONING ORDINANCE OF RAINSVILLE, ALABAMA, AND THE ZONING MAP CHANGING THE USE ZONE AND DISTRICT DESIGNATION OF A CERTAIN PARCEL LOCATED ON GARRETT STREET

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF RAINSVILLE, ALABAMA, as follows:

SECTION 1. Ordinance. The Official Zoning Map adopted as part of the Ordinance 08-15-1983 entitled Zoning Ordinance, of Rainsville, Alabama, is hereby amended to designate the following-described property, previously zoned as part of the Agricultural District, and rezoned to a zoning classification of R-1 Low Density Residential District.

Commence at an existing ½ inch iron pin in the pavement of Parker Avenue (50 ft ROW) marking the northwest corner of Section 31, Township 6 South, Range 8 East of the Huntsville Meridian and proceed South 00 degree 06 minutes 50 seconds West for a distance of 1,328.09 feet to an existing railroad spike in the pavement of Parker Avenue marking the southwest corner of the Northwest Quarter (NW1/4) of the Northwest Quarter (NW1/4) of said Section 31; thence proceed North 89 degrees 40 minutes 00 second East along the South boundary of said quarter-quarter for a distance of 27.76 feet to an existing one-half (1/2) inch iron pin on the East ROW boundary of Parker Avenue, said point being the point of beginning; thence proceed with the East ROW boundary of Parker Avenue along the following calls to the South ROW of Garrett Street (60 ft. ROW):

North 00 degree 16 minutes 05 seconds East for a distance of 334.08 feet to an iron pin set with cap (PLS # 11568); North 01 degree 00 minute 05 seconds East for a distance of 392.50 feet to an iron pin set with cap (PLS # 11568); North 00 degree 20 minutes 05 seconds west for a distance of 581.89 feet to an iron pin set with cap (PLS # 11568); North 01 degree 19 minutes 05 seconds west for a distance of 656.92 feet to an iron pin set with cap (PLS #11568) on the South ROW boundary of Garrett Street; thence proceed South 55 degrees 46 minutes 50 seconds East along the South ROW boundary of Garrett Street for a distance of 883.26 feet to an iron pin set with cap (PLS # 11568); thence continue with said ROW boundary along a curve to the left with a radius of 742.35 feet, an arc length of 361.23 feet and a chord of South 68 degrees 15 minutes 48 seconds East for a chord distance of 357.67 feet to an iron pin set with cap (PLS # 11568); thence continue with said ROW boundary along a second curve to the left with a radius of 4,159.04 feet, an arc length of 219.94 feet and a chord of South 82 degrees 18 minutes 31 seconds East for a chord distance of 219.92 feet to an iron pin set with a cap (PLS # 11568) on the West ROW boundary of Maple Avenue (50 ft ROW); thence proceed with the west ROW boundary of Maple Avenue along the following calls: South 03 degrees 07 minutes 00 second West for a distance of 346.36 feet to an iron pin set with cap (PLS # 11568); South 00 degree 10 minutes 00 second East for a distance of 397.75 feet to an iron pin set with cap (PLS # 11568); South 01 degree 16 minutes 50 seconds East for a distance of 555.72 feet to an existing ½ inch iron pin on the South Boundary of the Northwest Quarter (NW1/4) of the said Section 31;

thence leaving said ROW boundary, proceed South 89 degrees 40 minutes 00 second West, passing through an existing iron pin with cap (PLS # 23344) at a distance of 630.96 feet, for a total distance of 1,265.23 feet to the point of the beginning.

SAID PARCEL OF LAND LYING IN THE SOUTHWEST QUARTER (SW1/4) OF SECTION 30, AND THE NORTHWEST QUARTER OF SECTION 31, ALL IN THE TOWNSHIP 6 SOUTH, RANGE 8 EAST, CITY OF RAINSVILLE, DEKALB COUNTY, ALABAMA AND CONTAINING 44.91 ACRES MORE OR LESS.

The present zoning classification of this property is Agricultural District with, the proposed change to a zoning classification of R-1 Low Density Residential District.

SECTION 2. Map. The Official Zoning Map exhibited in Rainsville City Hall shall be changed and amended to reflect the changed zoning designation effected and set out by this ordinance.
