

## ORDINANCE NO. 4-4-11

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 2-17-11 MUNICIPAL SALES AND USE TAX TO MAKE EFFECTIVE DATE OF TAX AND ORDINANCE MAY 1, 2011

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF RAINSVILLE, ALABAMA, as follows:

**SECTION 1 – Purpose and Reasons.** The Rainsville City Council passed its Ordinance No. 2-17-11 *An Ordinance To Levy And Define A Municipal Sales And Use Tax Upon Retail Sales And/Or Use Of Certain Items And Services Sold Or Used Within The Rainsville Corporate Limits And Police Jurisdiction* on February 17, 2011. Ordinance No. 2-17-11 provided that it became effective immediately upon publication. That Ordinance was then published on February 24, 2011. The Mayor and Council have determined that it would be more proper and effective to provide an effective date of Ordinance No. 2-17-11 and the taxes provided therein that will allow the City to give a 30-day notice to the taxpayers located in the corporate boundaries and police jurisdiction of the City.

**SECTION 2 – Notice To Taxpayers.** The Rainsville City Council has caused a notice of the new and amended Sales and Use Tax Ordinance to be issued to all know taxpayers affected thereby and located within the corporate boundaries and police jurisdiction of the City on or about April 1, 2011, that such taxes and Ordinance will become effective on May 1, 2011.

**SECTION 3 – Amendment.** Section 27 of Ordinance No. 2-17-11 is hereby amended to provide that Ordinance No. 2-17-11 become effective on May 1, 2011.

**SECTION 4 – Balance Of Ordinance Remains Unchanged.** All provisions of Ordinance No. 2-17-11 not specifically modified or amended hereby remain in full force and effect on their existing terms.
