AMENDMENT TO ZONING ORDINANCE

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE ZONING ORDINANCE NUMBER 8-15-83
ENTITLED ZONING ORDINANCE OF RAINSVILLE, ALABAMA, AS
PREVIOUSLY AMENDED TO ADD ELEMENTARY SCHOOLS AND HIGH
SCHOOLS AS A SPECIAL EXCEPTION IN B-3 DISTRICT

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF RAINSVILLE, ALABAMA, as follows:

SECTION 1. Article IV Use Districts of the Rainsville Zoning Ordinance Number 8-15-83, Section 4-6. B-3 General Business District, Subsection 4-6-2 Special Exceptions, shall be, and is hereby, amended to read as follows:

- “• Automobile repair service
- Retail outlets for building materials provided no manufacturing or fabricating is conducted on the premises
- Bus passenger stations
- Public elementary and high schools and private elementary and high schools having curricula substantially the same as that ordinarily followed in public schools.”


