## CITY OF RAINSVILLE RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the City of Rainsville, Alabama, recognizes the need for a recreational trail for both health and recreational reasons; and

WHEREAS, the Alabama Department of Economic and Community Affairs has authorized the making of grants to aid in financing the cost of such projects through the Recreational Trails Program.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Rainsville City Council that the Mayor be hereby authorized to submit an pre-application to the Alabama Department of Economic and Community Affairs (ADECA) on behalf of the City for the proposed Recreational Trails project, not to exceed \$10,000. ADECA funding for the project will be 80% of the project, not to exceed \$80,000. The City of Rainsville hereby commits to provide local matching funds in the amount of 20% of the total project, not to exceed \$20,000; and

FURTHERMORE, the City is willing to pursue this project until its completion.

BE IT FURTHERMORE RESOLVED, that in the event the grant is awarded, the City understands that it will sign assurances to comply with all applicable Federal and State laws, rules, and regulations.
